Here's a tiny two inch space for you to write in: why don't you describe yourself? Can you fit it in?

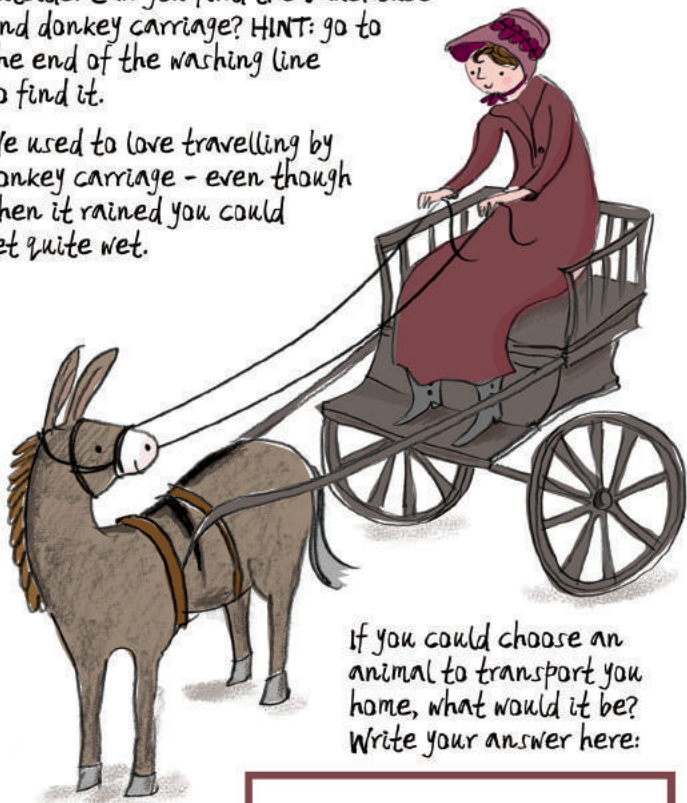

## THE DINING ROOM

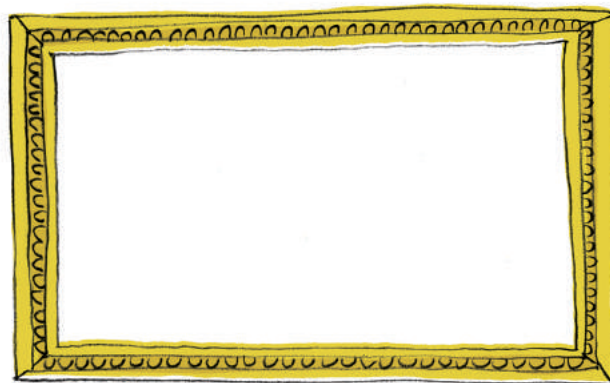
Now you've seen the main house, have a look around outside. Can you find the bakehouse and donkey carriage? HINT: go to the end of the washing line to find it.

# Jane Austen's House



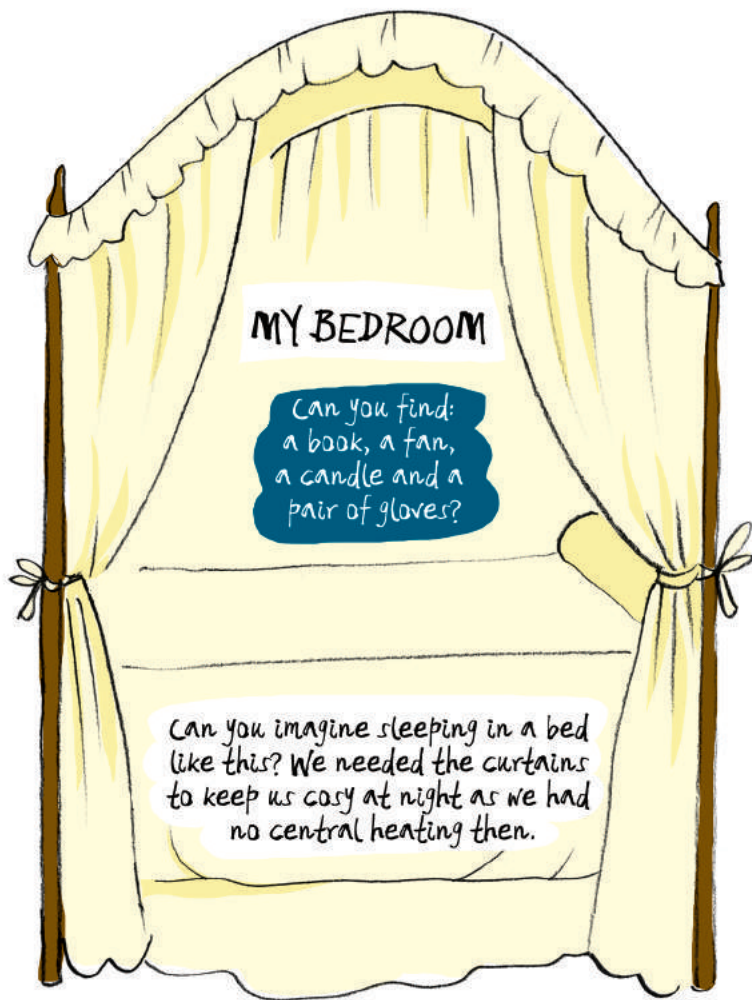
Hello! Welcome to my home. I lived here with my mother and my sister and we always loved having my little nieces and nephews to visit. Come with me, I'll show you round!

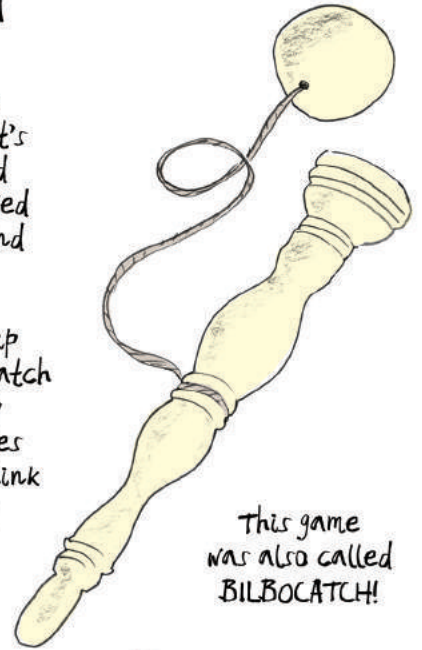




## FAMILY ROOM

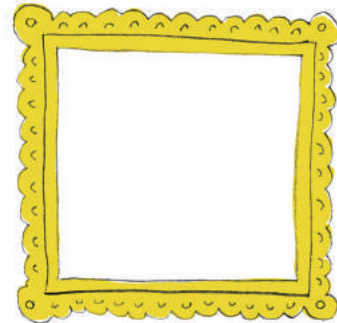
Have a look in the corner cabinet - it's filled with toys and games that we played with my nephews and nieces.

Can you see the cup and ball? I could catch the ball in the cup ONE HUNDRED times in a row! Do you think you could do that?



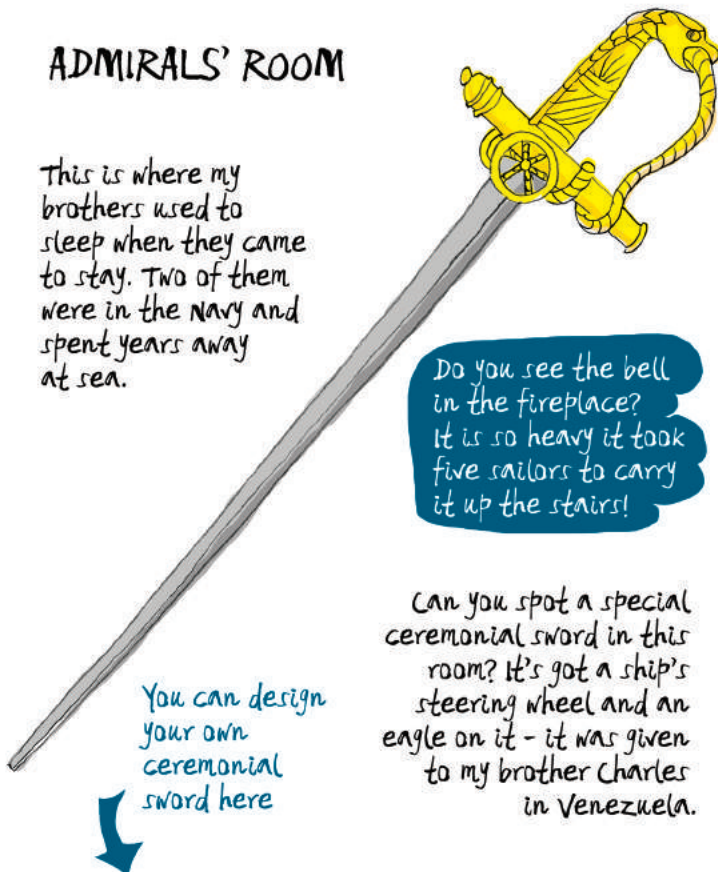
This game was also called BILBOCATCH!

This room is full of portraits - some very large and grand and some very small ones that were called 'minatures'. Here is a very small space for you to draw a minature portrait of yourself:

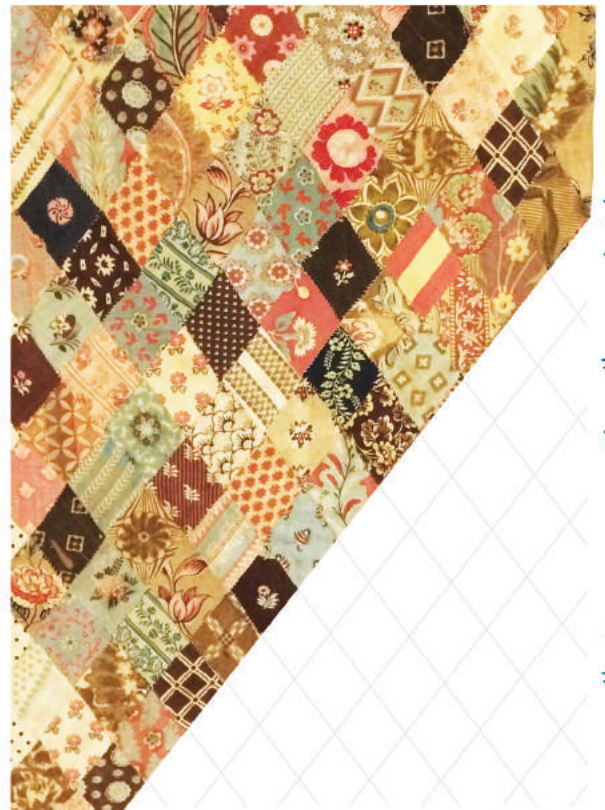


## ADMIRALS' ROOM
