What's Involved?

- Being part of the volunteer gardening team of Jane Austen's House
- Weeding, watering, pruning and general gardening duties
- Support the museum's mission to be environmentally conscientious
- Thinking about the needs of all visitors, including disabled people and families
- Getting to know health and safety and evacuation procedures
- Following the JAH code of conduct.

How much time would you need to give?

At least one morning every two weeks, on either Tuesday or Fridays

This role will suit you if you....

- Enjoy gardening!
- Have some basic gardening knowledge
- Love history, and the idea of being hands on outdoors
- Have a great attention to detail
- Are relatively flexible, and capable of some light lifting

- Love Jane Austen! (This is actually not essential, but having a strong interest in English Literature, the Regency period or sharing stories from the past is important. You will pick up lots of facts and information through volunteering.)
- Are available at least once a fortnight on a Tuesday or Friday
- Would like to join a busy, lively, and supportive team and be part of sharing the stories of Jane Austen's House.

Things to know....

- This is physical work, requiring bending and some light lifting
- Our gardeners work throughout the year
- All volunteer gardeners work only under the direct supervision of our Head Gardener
- Gardeners work only on Tuesdays and Fridays.
